

Nonfiction Book Project Guidelines

All projects, regardless of type, must include the following content:

- 10 headings (10 of the most important or interesting topics from your book)
- 3 facts under each heading (these facts should relate back to the heading)
- 3-5 minutes of prepared information to discuss with your group, such as:
 - What you liked/disliked about the book
 - How the text features and format of the nonfiction book helped you
 - What you think the author did well
 - Other appropriate and relevant comments

Choose one of the following types:

Poster—make it visually appealing, use lots of color, arrange and use text features correctly

Pamphlet—make it visually appealing, use lots of color, arrange and use text features correctly (I'll show you how to fold it!)

PowerPoint—min. of 11 slides (one per heading, and a title slide), make it visually appealing.

VidEditor Free (an app for iPhone, iPad, etc)—min. of 10 clips, one for each heading.
